

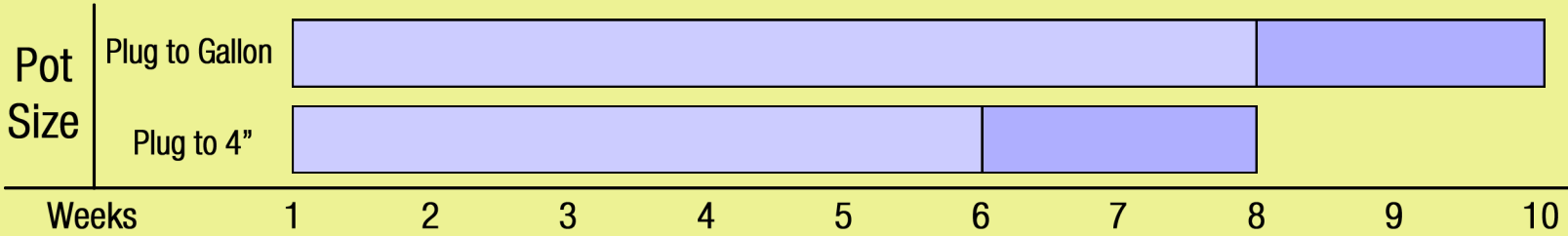

pH: 5.6 - 6.8

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Sun to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

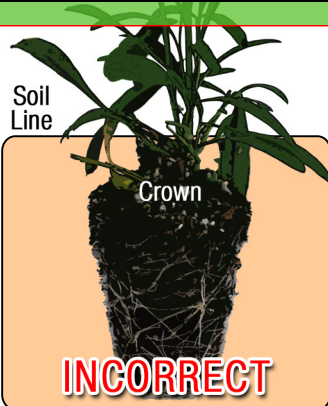
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Foliar nematodes may be a problem for gardens in susceptible areas and watch for root weevils.

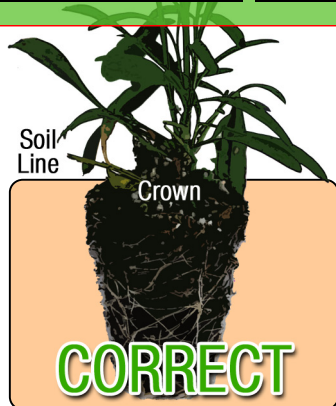
Habit: Trailing

Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture or poor drainage. **Note**: All Heucherella are rust resistant.

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

Description

The first GROUNDCOVER Heucherella. Mounding then sending out trailing stems and spreading low. Wonderful, warm autumnal tones interweave throughout the foliage. Broadly lobed leaves with dark veins that change colors with the seasons. Good spilling out of a container in sun or shade or use in your mixed beds. H. villosa breeding enhance the usability in many regions. Vigorous grower.
