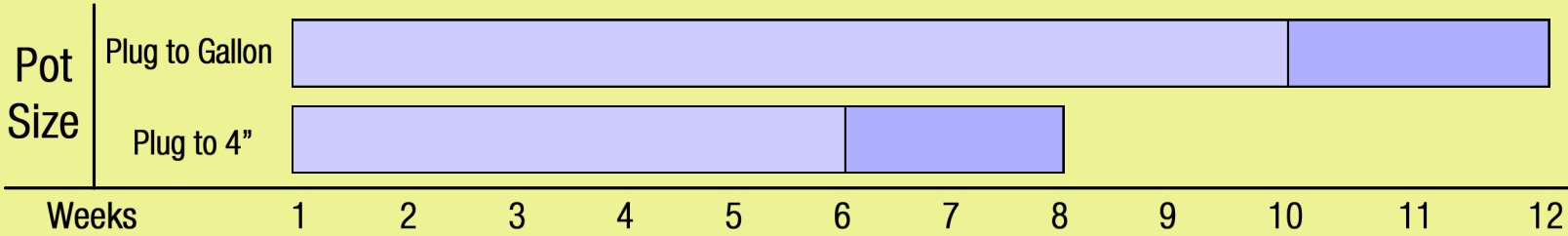


Growing Recipe

LEUCANTHEMUM 'GOLDFINCH'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

pH: 5.8 - 6.8

Fertilization Recommendations: 50 - 100 PPM (Weekly)

EC: 0.5 - 1.0

Light Levels: Full sun

Water Requirements: Dry slightly between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 5 - 8

Possible Problems: Insect: Aphids and slugs are possible problems

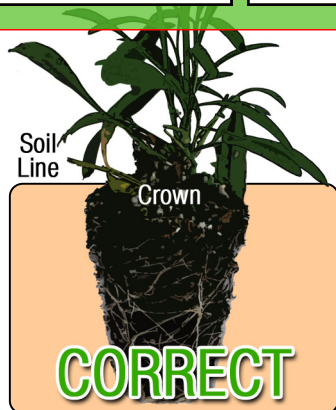
Habit: Clumping

Diseases: No major diseases

Day Length for Flowering: Facultative Long Day

This is the yellowest flowering Shasta daisy ever! Long blooming and compact with semi-double flowers, 'Goldfinch' is the product of years of breeding for yellow flowers. All other "yellow" Leucanthemum pale in comparison! Charming semi-double flowers, very slowly and gracefully change from bright lemon yellow to an ivory white. A real gem, amongst the bland Leucanthemum market.
