

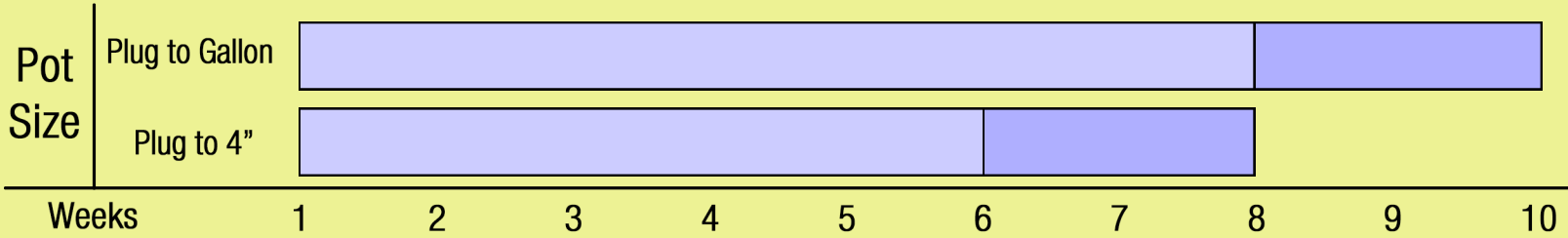

pH: 5.8 - 6.2

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Shade to part sun

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Foliar nematodes may be a problem for gardens in susceptible areas. Watch for root weevils.

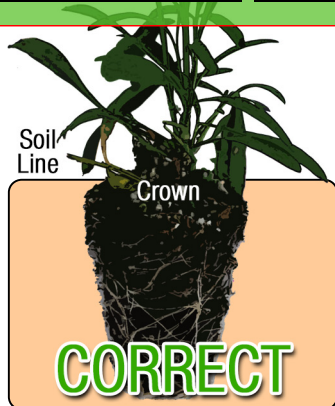
Habit: Mounding

Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture. Powdery mildew, rust, and leaf spots may occur.

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

## Description

New breeding lines for TERRA NOVA®. This H. richardsonii hybrid is a great long-lived landscape plant with a multiple crowns with round, lime green leaves that stay lime green all year. It forms a dense rounded mound and has narrow spikes of yellow green flowers. No problems with Heuchera rust here in the NW for 4 years. Use in borders, mixed beds, woodland, or as an accent.
